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We understand this initial deposit **guarantees our reservation** and is **non-refundable after March 15, 2010**.

We understand our second payment of \$100.00 per person is to be postmarked by eight (8) weeks prior to the start of our camp week. We also understand that should we need to reduce our reserved space (and not suffer financial penalty) we should do this 8 weeks before our camp starts. **If we fail to reduce our numbers by this time we understand that we must pay the total camper fee for the number of reserved spaces, no matter our actual numbers.**

** We understand that our final payment of \$125.00 /per reserved space is due, along with our final roster, participant registration & medical release forms, in the office no later than **4 weeks prior to our camp week**. We realize our failure to do so may result in forfeiture of our reservations and our second payment (see Initial Deposit Fee for more refund information). **

We understand we will receive reminder notices of all payments and due dates for any other needed information, well in advance of the actual due date.

Application Procedure and Information

1. **Read** the entire application booklet and be aware of policies and requirements before completing application. Upon acceptance of your application, you agree to meet the policies and requirements contained within this booklet. We suggest reviewing the information enclosed in this pamphlet with your total youth group.
2. The group application must be **reviewed** and **completed** by the entire group, not just one person. This will encourage total group commitment.
3. Groups are accepted on a first come, first served basis, so get your **DEPOSIT** in early!
4. The minimum age requirement is entering 7th grade and at least 12 years of age.
5. You *must* have the proper ratio of driving adults to non-driving members of your group (1 to 5).
6. You *must* have the proper number of vehicles. Remember, vehicles must be capable of hauling 6 or 7 people and their tools to work sites during the week. Many groups need to rent vans to make the trip – factor this into your planning and fundraising for your trip.
7. You will arrive in camp on Sunday afternoon and leave camp on Saturday morning. Those who are unable to meet these requirements should not participate in PNCC.
8. The total camp community will be divided into work teams of 6 or 7 people and have a balance of ages, genders, skills, and church groups. Your group will be added to the camp group, which is then divided into teams. New friendships are forged and community building skills are enhanced.
9. You will receive a camp week assignment shortly after returning your application.
10. You will receive camper training materials following receipt of deposit, or earlier, if you request it!
11. It is to your advantage to complete and submit applications as soon as possible; this will help ensure your group gets to participate in PNCC 2010 and increases chances of receiving your first preference of camp weeks.
